

# Dress Code for the Ballet Program 2009-2010

**Boys:** Short-sleeved white leotards with black tights, thin white ankle-length dance socks (no tube socks) and white ballet shoes. (Hair should be combed and fastened away from face if long.)

**Girls:** Must wear hair slicked back in either a secure bun or other style that has the hair securely fastened to the head. Please, no bangs or jewelry. Child size tights should be Capezio style number 9C in the classical pink color. An alternative children's tights option is the Body Wrappers equivalent, which is sold at Pom Pom's and Pirouettes. Adult size tights should be Danskin style number 71 in the theatrical pink color. See below for additional attire requirements for girls.

## **Premier Ballet, Intermediate A, B, C, and D Ballet:**

- A solid black leotard (no skirts attached)  
Preferred leotard is Sansha Tank, style C160C, black

## **Advanced Ballet:**

- Any solid color leotard (no skirts attached)
- Pink leather or canvas ballet shoes with shoe strings knotted, trimmed, and tucked on the inside of the shoe.
- Always come to class prepared for pointe work
